## WORCESTER-SCHENEVUS LIBRARY OFFICIAL MINUTES: June 9, 2021 170 Main Street, Worcester, New York 12197

The June Worcester-Schenevus Library Board of Trustees meeting was held via Zoom on June 9th, 2021 due to the increased risk of infection of COVID-19.

Diane Addesso, President of the Board of Trustees, called the meeting to order at 6:09 p.m. In attendance, Trustees John Tauzel, Scott Brady, Barb Hamil, Jo-Ann Scheiner and Christy Deitchman were present, as was Library Director, Antoinette Basso. Chriss Odell was not present. Jay Deitchman was present as Zoom Meeting Coordinator.

**Minutes** – A motion (Tauzel, Hamil) to accept the Minutes of the May 12th, 2021 Trustees Meeting, was approved.

Treasurer's Report - A motion (Hamil, Scheiner) to pay monthly bills, was approved.

**Director's Report** – Mask guidelines will follow school mandate which require masks to be worn in the building and Toni will find out what 4 County regulations are, including sign in sheets and mask regulations. After a short discussion, it was decided to use the current mask guidelines and statement from Huntington Memorial Library until verified by 4 County. Fire ladder was purchased and is only recommended for one time use. 20 kids and 1 adult have signed up for the Summer Reading Program. The Board is encouraged to sign up for the Summer Reading Program as well. Donna Jo will be bringing students in for library cards.

**Old/New Business -** Strawberry Festival plans include a current map for sales with only four addresses currently listed. Schenevus Market is having a strawberry theme on the same day as the Worcester Strawberry Festival. High School Jazz Band will not be playing. Diane found an alternate group for \$200 for duo and \$300 for a trio for a total of 1½ hours. It was agreed that the trio option would be best and would be paid \$300 to play for the Strawberry Festival.

A motion (Hamil, Brady) to adjourn, carried unanimously. President Addesso adjourned the meeting at 6:45 p.m.
